Friday June 16th, 2023 Davidsbündler Feestconcert at the Concertgebouw (Amsterdam)

The climax of our first season's celebration takes place at the Concertgebouw Amsterdam, the hall which is so meaningful to Davidsbündler Music Academy's founders Anna Fedorova and Nicholas Schwartz. Anna Fedorova "the house pianist of the Concertgebouw" (*Trouw*), has performed at the Concertgebouw over 50 times. Nicholas Schwartz has been a member of the Concertgebouw Orchestra since 2013. This celebratory concert showcases highlights from the academy's first year. Professors of the Davidsbündler Music Academy will perform alongside our piano students, who have won over 20 international piano competitions during the first season. We present our unique "Side-by-Side" initiative as students share the stage with their mentors in Vladimir Mendelssohn's arrangement of Tchaikovsky's *Romeo and Juliet*. We also hope that you will enjoy the Amsterdam premiere of Vasks' *6th String Quartet* as well as Borys Fedorov's *Adventures of Mowgli*.

The Academy offers Side-by-Side chamber music workshops, performances and masterclasses to its students throughout the year. On June 17th, the Academy will host masterclasses with the legendary pianist and pedagogue Norma Fisher at Studio 150, Bethlehemkerk, Amsterdam. Norma Fisher is Professor of Piano at the Royal College of Music in London and has mentored many of the world's leading pianists including Anna Fedorova.

On the same day, the Academy will offer a Q&A session with Marco Riaskoff, the promoter responsible for the renowned Meesterpianist series in the Concertgebouw. The aim of our Q&A sessions is to provide students with the opportunity to receive advice from leading figures from the music industry.
